Award

This scholarship award is for \$1000. The award will be allocated evenly over the fall, winter and spring terms immediately following the award of this scholarship. Two awards are available.

Eligibility

- Be admitted to EOU for fall term of the academic year for which they seek the scholarship.
- Be members of BMCC Phi Theta Kappa with at least 30 college-level transfer credits.
- Complete an application available through BMCC - Phi Theta Kappa.
- Maintain full-time status (minimum of 12 credits per term) with EOU.

Conditions

- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- It is preferred that your application be typed.
- After the deadline, BMCC Scholarship Committees will review your application. You will receive notification about selections. You may be expected to attend a scholarship event in the spring and be introduced to donors and scholarship supporters. If you do not meet the criteria or are not selected for any scholarship, you will be notified.
- All scholarships awards are to be used while attending Eastern Oregon University for the 2017-2018 academic years.
- EOU scholarships are nontransferable, nonrenewable and may not be used during succeeding academic years.
- To continue receiving your scholarship, you must meet eligibility requirements each term. Scholarship recipients **must complete at least 12 credits with a minimum 2.0 GPA each term** to continue receiving the next term's scholarship. If you do not meet the requirements at the end of any given term, your scholarship will be canceled for the remainder of the academic year.
- The decision of the selection committee is final.
- Scholarship recipients' names will appear in press releases.
