To be eligible to receive Federal Financial Aid (grants, loans, and work-study funds), you must meet each of the following requirements:

- Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible noncitizen with a valid Social Security number.
- Have a valid Social Security number (with the exception of student from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau).
- Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a credit student working toward a degree or certificate in an eligible program.
- Maintain satisfactory [Academic Progress \(AP\)](#)
- Have a high school diploma or GED (Modified Diploma is eligible but Extended Diploma is not eligible).
- Be registered with [Selective Service](#) if you are a male (you must register between the ages of 18 ad 25)
- Not be in default on a student loan or owe an overpayment or repayment to a financial aid program.
- If you have ever been convicted of sale or possession of illegal drugs while you were receiving Federal student aid you must meet additional eligibility requirements and submit the [Question 23 Worksheet PDF](#) (or [in Spanish PDF](#)).
- Demonstrate financial need (for most programs)
