For the Bachelor’s of Science major in nursing at Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU), at least 9 credits must be from the Humanities (Arts & Letters). There is also a language requirement and at least 15 non-nursing elective credits must be upper division (300 or 400 level Arts, Letters & Science courses), with a total of 180 credits over the 4 years of curriculum.

(i.e.: WR121(3), WR122(3), & WR227) OR WR121(4) & WR227. Writing sequence must be completed by Spring term of Year 2 (required in order to transfer to another OCNE school after Year 2).
