



**BMCC & Linn-Benton Community College
Diagnostic Imaging Technology Program
2012 Admission and Point System**

Blue Mountain Community College will have **two (2)** positions available for Summer 2012 admission.

BMCC's Admission Office must receive all materials at the time of application. **Application period: January 4, 2012 through January 20, 2012.** Application and all materials must be received by Blue Mountain Community College – Pendleton location on or before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 20, 2012. Applications or documents received after that date will **not** be accepted.

All coursework eligible to be counted for admission points must have been completed at a *regionally accredited* school during or prior to Fall term 2011 with a grade of "C" or better. Winter 2012 coursework will **not** be considered for points.

Official transcript/s from other schools must be either attached with your application in a sealed envelope or be sent directly to BMCC attention: Theresa Bosworth/Admissions. All course numbers listed below are BMCC courses as described in BMCC's catalog. You can view BMCC's academic catalog by going to <http://www.bluecc.edu/catalogs>

All coursework must have been completed with a grade of "C" or better. Only college level courses will count towards points. **BMCC ADMISSION POINT SYSTEM – Grade's with a plus (+) or minus (-) do not apply.**

SECTION A: GRADE BASED COURSES (Maximum pts: 42)

All courses in this section are required for admission to this program and must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher during or prior to Fall term 2011. Grades used for points in this section as indicated below.

- **Anatomy & Physiology:** BI231
- **Medical Terminology:** BT251
- **College Algebra:** MTH111 (**taken after June 18, 2007**)
- **Health/PE:** HE252, HPE295, PE291, PE292, **or** 3 credits of PE185
- **Communication:** COM100, 111 **or** 112
- **Writing:** WR121
- **Cultural Literacy (1 course):** ANTH103, COM115, COM237, ENG107-109, ENG240, ENG253, ENG260, GEOG103, GEOG120, HST201-203, SOC204, SOC213, SOC217 or other coursework that is equivalent to courses listed on pages 167-168 of LBCC's 2011/12 Academic Catalog.

NOTE: Science & Society course requirement (1 course): This is required for LBCC's AAS program. This course is to be taken from Linn-Benton CC once admitted to the program and concurrent with other program coursework. For Summer 2013 admission this course requirement must be met along with other pre-admit course requirements. Currently acceptable coursework: ANS121, BI101-103, BI211-213, CH221-223, G101, G103, G201-203, GS104, GS105, PHY201-203, or PHY211-213.

SECTION B: SUPPORT COURSES (Maximum pts: 18)

Points based on number of courses taken and passed with a “C” or better. **Each** course completed will count as 2 points regardless of grade received.

- **Anatomy & Physiology:** BI232, 233 (maximum 4 pts)
- **College level Biology with lab:** BI101, 102, 103 (maximum 2 pts)
- **College level Chemistry with lab:** CH104 or higher (maximum 2 pts)
- **College level Physics with lab:** PHY201, 202, 203, 211, 212, 213 (maximum 4 pts: PHY201-203 OR PHY211-213 - only 1 course in each series will be counted)
- **General Science with lab:** GS104 or GS105 (maximum 2 pts)
- **Digital Literacy:** CS120 (maximum 2 pts)
- **Medical Terminology II:** BT252 (maximum 2 pts)

SECTION C: EDUCATION (Maximum pts: 3)

Official transcript(s) sealed from each institution from which a degree has been awarded must be submitted with the application.

SECTION D: DOCUMENTED JOB SHADOW/WORK EXPERIENCE (Maximum pts: 4)

You may receive points for job shadow or work experience in a diagnostic imaging clinical setting and/or experience in a health-care environment with direct patient contact. You must complete one form per employer/agency. Form available on website.

DOCUMENTED JOB SHADOW/WORK EXPERIENCE – TYPE	POINTS
Job Shadow in a Diagnostic Facility (16 – 24 hours)	1
Job Shadow in a Diagnostic Facility (25 + hours)	2
Paid Employment in a Diagnostic Facility with direct patient contact (6 or more months)	3
Paid Employment in a certified health care field with direct patient contact (ie: CNA, CMA) – 6 or more months.	4

SECTION E: PRIOR APPLICANT (Maximum pts: 2)

_____ Applicants who were alternates to BMCC/Linn-Benton Community College’s Diagnostic Imaging 2011 Program who received a minimum of 50 points and were not give an opportunity to enter the program.

SECTION F: PREREQUISITE COURSES FROM BMCC (Maximum pts: 6)

- All prerequisite courses taken from BMCC: 6 points**
- At least 50% of prerequisite courses taken from BMCC : 1 points**
- Less than 50% of prerequisite courses taken from BMCC: 0 points**

SECTION G: WRITTEN EXPERIENTIAL ASSESSMENT (Maximum pts: 25)

SECTION H: INTERVIEW WITH CLINICAL SITE SUPERVISORS/STAFF (Maximum pts: 50)

The top four (4) applicants will be required to participate in this process. Tentatively, interviews to take place during the first week of February 2012. Students will be notified when date has been set.
