Friday, May 13 Starts at 10:00 a.m.

- **Breakaway Roping:** One loop only.
- **Team Roping:** Two loops only.
- **Timed Events:** Must split horses one hour before the performance or both riders will be fined \$10 each.
- **Rough Stock:** One head each.
- **Barrel Racing:** Barrels will be run first at 10:00 a.m. The ground will be raked after every 10 contestants.

No companion passes will be issued.

Only the contestant that is competing will be allowed in the arena.

Steer wrestlers sharing horses will be required to have an individual catching the horse after the run (besides the hazer).

Horses may not be tied to fences. A \$10 fine for each occurrence and horses will be removed at owners expense. This will be strictly enforced.

Horses will not be allowed on the grassed areas of the Umatilla County Fair Grounds.

Stalls will be available to rent. \$15/horse per night. Stall assignments will be issued at the time contestants enter the fairgrounds and fees will be collected.

Contestants will be issued a wrist band when they pay their entry fees. Wrist bands must be worn and presented to enter the fairgrounds and arena area. Contestants will be charged \$25 for a replacement wrist band.

It will be ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY that each contestant keep his/her vehicle and trailer in the contestants parking area only. All contestants and coaches will need to enter the Umatilla County Fair Grounds on Orchard Ave. in Hermiston.
