GENERAL PROGRAM ADMISSION INFORMATION

Application materials are available on the Blue Mountain Community College's (BMCC) website (www.bluecc.edu) and must be completed and on file in the Admissions Office on or prior to **Monday, April 27, 2009**.

1. Incomplete applications will not be considered in the priority admission process.
2. Applicants must meet BMCC's general admission requirements to be eligible to apply for admission to the Dental Assisting Technician certificate program.
3. Applicants will be notified by email of their tentative program admission status on or after Monday, May 11, 2009.
4. 17 spaces are available for the 2009-10 academic year.
5. Applicants must be in good academic and financial standing with the college. An applicant who is not in good academic or financial standing with the college will not be considered for admission to this program.

Note: Students that have been fully and tentatively admitted to the program will be required to attend a mandatory orientation on **June 3, 2009**.

Criminal Background Check

Applicants must:

- Have paid for and successfully passed the criminal background check according to BMCC's 2009-10 Dental - List of Disqualifying Offenses.
- Have had their background check done on or after Monday, February 2, 2009.
- Have been received by BMCC from the Oregon State Police no later than Monday, June 15, 2009 for priority admission purposes.
- Email notifications will be sent to students regarding status of criminal background check.

NEW GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR 2009-10 – COMPUTER LITERACY

All students will also need to meet the computer literacy requirement for graduation purposes. To meet this requirement you must:

- Take and pass AGR111, or BA131, or CS130, or ED235; OR
- Take and pass BMCC's computer literacy placement assessment with a score of 85% or higher .

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

SECTION A – Application requirements

Applicants must submit the following to the Registrar's Office by Monday, April 27, 2009 to be considered for priority admissions purposes:

1. Completed BMCC 2009-10 Dental Admission Application Enclosure List
2. Completed BMCC 2009-10 Application for Admission – Limited Entry Program form.
3. Completed BMCC 2009-10 Dental Assisting Technician – Statement of Understanding and Compliance
4. Official High School Transcript or GED Transcript.
5. OTHER COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS: If you wish to have credits from a college other than BMCC to be evaluated and considered to meet program entry requirements you must attach official sealed transcripts from those colleges and/or universities with your application packet. **Note:** BMCC does not accept credits from colleges that are not regionally accredited or from foreign institutions.
6. Proof that you will be 18 before November 1, 2009. Provide copy of valid driver's license **or** birth certificate.

SECTION B – GPA requirement

1. GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 or better.
2. GPA is computed only on the courses listed under Section D that have been completed by Monday, April 20, 2009. GPA will not be recomputed to include courses completed after that date.

SECTION C – Compass Placement requirements

Students entering BMCC's Dental Assisting Technician certificate program must be able to read at or above a college level. To meet this requirement applicants must:

- Passed RD120 (Critical Reading & Thinking) with a grade of "C" or higher; **OR**
- Have taken the Compass Reading assessment with a score of 88 or higher.

SECTION D – Course requirements – All courses must be completed with a "C" or higher

1. **Writing:** WR060 (Elements of Essay) or above
2. **Mathematics:** MTH025 (Pre-Algebra) or above
3. **Oral Communication:** SP100 (Human Communications) or above
4. **Human Relations:** Humanities (except Speech) or Social Science, Courses from page 40 & 41 of the 08-09 catalog and/or BA285, HD100, RD120. Students are encouraged to take PSY201 **OR** HD100 as their Human Relations course. **Recommended course: HD100 or RD120**

SECTION E – Criminal Background Check

Applicants must have paid for and successfully passed the criminal background check according to BMCC's 2009-10 List of Disqualifying Offenses. Results must be received by BMCC from OSP no later than Monday, June 15, 2009.

ADMISSION RANKING

Applicants that meet admission requirements will be considered as follows. **In all groups:**

- **The higher the GPA the higher the ranking within that group.**
- **Successfully passing the criminal background check as defined under the “General Program Information” section.**

Priority Group 1:

- Applicants who have met all requirements listed in Sections A, B, C and D by Monday, April 20, 2009
- Successfully passed criminal background check, results received by BMCC from O.S.P.

Priority Group 2:

- Applicants who have met all requirements in Section A by Monday, April 20, 2009; **AND**
- Applicants who have met all requirements in Sections B, C and D by June 12, 2009.

Priority Group 3:

- Application’s received after the priority admission application deadline of Monday, April 20, 2009; **OR**
- Applicants who have met all requirements of Section B, C or D by the end of Summer Term 2009 (August 31, 2009).

Priority Group 4:

- Late applicants and or all other’s that do not meet the Priority Group 1 – 3 requirements.

These applications will be addressed on a case-by-case basis and in date completed order.
