AND MATHEMATICS (S-STEM)**

ABOUT THE S-STEM SCHOLARSHIP

The Transition to University and Careers Program aims to enhance successful transition for qualified science, technology, engineering and mathematics students from a community college, including any of the seventeen partner Community Colleges in Oregon to the University Honors College at Oregon State University. Scholars will participate in a program to ease the transition to University life. Recipients can receive up to \$5,000 for one year. Twenty scholarships may be awarded annually.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must:

- Currently be enrolled at a community or junior college, including one of the 17 community colleges in Oregon (Degree Partnership students are welcome.)
- Have a cumulative college GPA of 3.25 or above.
- Have unmet financial need as documented by FAFSA.
- Transfer to OSU (Corvallis campus) with a declared major in one of the STEM disciplines.
- Apply to the University Honors College by February 1st.
- Be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.

Transition to University and Careers Program Oregon State University

NSF Grant: Scholarships in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (S-STEM)

Duration: April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2015

Objective: The Transition to University and Careers Program aims to enhance successful transition for qualified science, technology, engineering and mathematics students from any Community College (including the seventeen partner Community Colleges in Oregon) to the University Honors College at Oregon State University. Scholars will participate in a program to ease the transition to University life.

Scholarship: One year, up to \$5,000. Up to 20 scholarships awarded annually.

Application:

Applicants must:

- Currently be enrolled in a Community College. (Degree Partnership students are welcome.)
- Have a cumulative college GPA of at least 3.25.
- Have unmet financial need as documented by FAFSA.
- Transfer to OSU (Corvallis campus) with a declared major in one of the STEM disciplines.
- Apply to the University Honors College by February 1st.
- Be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.
