Purpose/Principle/Definitions:

The College is committed to working with Operations, the Safety Committee, the public, and law enforcement agencies to reduce the opportunity for sexual assault on any College campus, branch, or delivery site as well as at off-campus College-sponsored events.

Students may obtain information regarding registered sex offenders as well as the College's campus sexual assault programs from the College web site, the Enrollment Management Unit, Operations, and such means as the student handbook and postings.

Guidelines:

The College campus sexual assault program includes:

1. The promotion of awareness regarding rape, acquaintance rape, and other sex offenses.
2. College staff awareness on referring a student to the local police and/or the Enrollment Management Unit when a sex offense has occurred.
3. Information for students on contacting the local police department when a sex offense occurs and on contacting an appropriate College administrator who will be expected to work with the student using the complaint guidelines set forth in the student handbook.
4. The procedures for disciplinary action in cases of alleged sexual assault, which

afford the accuser and the accused the same opportunities to have others present during the proceeding and which informs both parties of the outcome of the disciplinary proceeding, as outlined in the student handbook.

5. Information regarding existing counseling, mental health, or student services for victims of sexual assault.
6. Information regarding assistance in changing academic situations after an alleged assault, which will be handled by the AVP, Enrollment Management or his/her designee.
