Subscribe by Mail & Save!

- ... Join us for all three productions and save \$5 on Adult tickets! Three plays for \$25!
- ... Subscriptions will be processed in the order received. If you wish to **sit with friends**, please include all orders in one envelope. If you wish to **order extra tickets** for any of the individual shows, please include a note with your order form.
- ... If your schedule changes, we'll gladly **exchange your tickets** for another performance of the same show, with tickets as close to your own as possible. If you miss your performance and have been unable to arrange for an exchange in advance, you have a "standby subscriber ticket privilege." Just present your subscriber tickets at the Box Office 30 minutes prior to the curtain time of the show you wish to attend.
- ... **Lost tickets?** We can replace them at no charge.
- ... Bringing a **group of ten** or more? Non-school groups receive \$2 off the price of admission; school groups pay half price on all tickets.
- ... **Wheelchair seating** is available. Please contact the Box Office (541-278-5953) in advance.
- ... **Hard of hearing?** We provide a **Wireless Hearing Assistance System**, available at no charge. Inquire at the Box Office.
- ... **If you, the ticket holder, are not in your seat at 10 minutes before curtain**, there is a possibility that your seat will be given to another patron. Should you arrive less than 10 minutes before curtain, and your seat is no longer available, we will 1) attempt to re-seat you, 2) refund your money, or 3) exchange your ticket to another performance, if possible. If you anticipate being late and unable to arrive by 10 minutes to curtain time, please call the CCT Box Office at 541-278-5953 and your seat can be held. If you arrive after the show has begun, it is possible that you may not be seated until intermission.
- ... **No children under three years old admitted.** Also, no youngsters will be allowed to sit on parents' lap in lieu of purchasing a ticket.
- ... **"Pay What You Can Night"** will be offered at each Final Dress Rehearsal (Thursday before Opening Night). No reservations will be taken, and it will feature "festival seating" (no assigned seats).
