

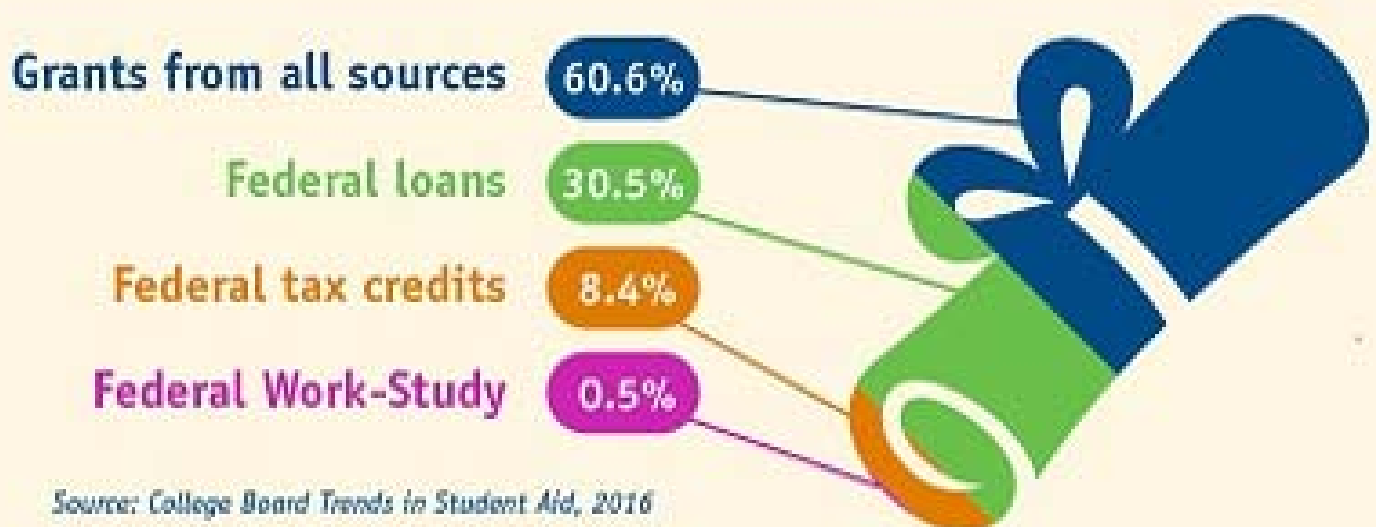
Grants by income level

In 2017-18, undergraduate students received an average of \$14,790 per FTE student in financial aid, including \$8,970 in grants, \$4,510 in federal loans, \$1,240 in education tax credits and deductions, and \$70 in Federal Work-Study (FWS)
