

HOW DO I RENEW MY OREGON PROMISE GRANT?

For Current Oregon Promise Recipients



Oregon Promise is a state grant that covers most tuition at any Oregon community college for recent high school graduates and GED recipients.

To renew your Oregon Promise application for next year, you must:

- File the 2017-2018 **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** or **Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA)** by **July 14, 2017**.
- List at least one Oregon community college on the FAFSA or ORSAA

To remain eligible for Oregon Promise, you must:

- Complete First-Year Experience as directed by the community college. First-Year Experience varies depending on the college. If you have questions, contact your college financial aid office.
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress, determined by your community college.
- Maintain at least half-time continuous enrollment (i.e. 6 or more credits) during fall, winter and spring terms each year.
- If you are selected for verification on the FAFSA, complete this process with your college financial aid office. You must complete verification before you will receive an Oregon Promise award.
- Have attempted or completed no more than 90 credits.
