Instructions

Your FAFSA was selected for review in a process called verification. The law states that BMCC collect certain information from you. To verify the information, we will compare the information on this verification with the FAFSA. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected.

Please check each box that applies and attach the document that will indicate high school completion status when the student begins college in 2020-2021:

- Standard High School Diploma (**Modified Diploma is eligible** but Extended Diploma is not eligible)
Options to document:
 - ✓ A copy of the standard high school diploma; or
 - ✓ A copy of the student's final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.

- Recognized Equivalent:
 - ✓ General Educational Development (GED) Certificate; or
 - ✓ An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree

NOTE: The following option is **not** available in Oregon.

- A state certificate or transcript received by a student after the student passed a State-authorized examination that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma.

- For students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.

- For a homeschool student, a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the parent or guardian, which lists the secondary school courses completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.

NOTE: The option below is **not** available in Oregon.

- For a homeschooled student in a state where state law requires the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.

A student who is unable to obtain the documentation listed above must contact the Financial Aid office.
