As part of the implementation of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act BMCC has developed the following criteria for disbursement of funds.

PART I: Federal Student Stimulus Scholarship (\$150) – FAFSA Filers

Students meeting all eligibility criteria below will receive a \$150 Federal Student Stimulus Scholarship. BMCC is awarding this amount to cover increases in utility use as a result of attending all courses online. Students do not need take any action and funds will be distributed via check or your BankMobile account.

- Must have filed a 2019/2020 FAFSA
- Be currently enrolled as a credit student working towards a degree or certificate in a financial aid eligible program
- Be currently meeting satisfactory [Academic Progress \(AP\)](#)

PART II: FAFSA Non-Filer Self-Certification for Federal Student Stimulus Scholarship (\$150)

Students that did not file the FAFSA may still qualify for the Stimulus Scholarship by submitting the following self-certification:

I certify that I meet all of these requirements (initial all boxes):

- I am a U.S. Citizen or an eligible noncitizen
- I am currently enrolled as a credit student working towards a financial aid eligible degree or certificate in a program.
- I am currently meeting satisfactory [Academic Progress \(AP\)](#)
- I have a high school diploma or GED (Modified Diploma is eligible but Extended Diploma is not eligible).
- I am registered with [Selective Service](#) (if male, you must register between the ages of 18 and 25)
- I am not defaulted on a student loan or owe an overpayment or repayment to a financial aid program.
- I have not been convicted for possession or sale of illegal drugs for an offense that occurred while receiving any federal student aid (grants, work-study, or loans).

- Financial Aid will notify the student of approval and amount of grant or denial and reason via email to their BMCC email account.
- The funds will be disbursed through checks or your existing BankMobile account.
