

## BMCC College Nights to draw for \$500 scholarships Oct. 22

PENDLETON, Ore. – Students interested in attending college are invited to attend one of two College Nights hosted by Blue Mountain Community College on Oct. 22 to learn more about how to start the process. College Nights will be held simultaneously on Oct. 22 from 6-8:30 p.m. at both the BMCC campus in Pendleton (Science & Tech Building, Rm. 200) and Hermiston High School (Commons).

The College Night event is free, and participants will enjoy free pizza and drinks while they attend presentations about why they should consider attending college, how to choose the right college or academic program, how to fund their college educations, how to search for scholarships, and how to avoid scholarship scams. Students may also receive assistance with filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
