BMCC seeks budget committee member

PENDLETON, Ore. – The Blue Mountain Community College Board of Education is seeking to appoint a member of the community to the College Budget Committee for a three-year term. In an effort to provide geographical representation across BMCC's three-county district, community members from the Baker City and Morrow County areas are encouraged to apply.

The BMCC Budget Committee consists of the seven elected members of the BMCC Board of Education, as well as seven appointed community members. Members are eligible to serve two three-year terms on the committee. Newly-appointed members can expect to receive an orientation to the process sometime during the February-March 2015 timeframe.

Interested applicants should send a letter of interest, including a description of their fiscal background and experience, to the BMCC President's Office, PO Box 100, Pendleton, OR 97801. Appointments to the BMCC Budget Committee are made by the Board of Education.

The Budget Committee will begin its review of the proposed budget in May, and normally meets twice for two-three hours each.
