BMCC Board seeks to fill vacancy in Baker County

BAKER CITY, Ore. – Blue Mountain Community College is seeking to fill a vacant position on its Board of Education for Zone 2 in Baker County. The vacancy comes following the Feb. 4 resignation of Werner Buehler. No one filed for the position in the May 2015 election either, so the Board now has the opportunity to appoint an interested candidate.

Zone 2 include Baker City precincts 4, 5 and 33; Baker County precinct 13; Durkee; Eagle Valley; Hereford; Irondyke; Keating; Pine Valley; Sumpter; and Unity.

Interested citizens in Zone 2 may apply for the Board position between July 6 and July 30. The BMCC Board of Education is expected to screen and appoint applicants at its Aug. 12 meeting. The applicants selected by the Board to fill the vacancies will serve in the positions through June 30, 2017.

Interested candidates should be a registered voter in Baker County, as well as a resident of one of the districts in that zone. Applicants must submit a letter of interest to the BMCC Board of Education, PO Box 100, Pendleton, OR 97801, by July 30, 2015.
