## BMCC women's basketball standout Heugly signs with Western Oregon

PENDLETON, Ore. – Blue Mountain Community College women's basketball star Savannah Heugly has signed her letter of intent to continue her collegiate basketball career with Western Oregon University in Monmouth next year. The sophomore from Tualatin, Ore., has played for the Lady Timberwolves for the past two seasons.

The letter of intent caps off a stellar basketball career at BMCC for Heugly, a 5'11" guard. In the 2015-2016 season, Heugly averaged 21.29 points, 2.54 steals, and 11.32 rebounds per game, with an average of 7.36 defensive rebounds per game. She was named the Northwest Athletic Conference (NWAC) Player of the Week for the week of Jan. 12 for her outstanding performance against Columbia Basin College on Jan. 9, when she scored 26 points and pulled down 15 rebounds, including two assists, a block and a steal. She ranked fourth in the NWAC for the season in scoring (596 total points), seventh in rebounding (317 total) and field goals (253 total), 13<sup>th</sup> in steals (71 total), and 15<sup>th</sup> in blocks (23 total). She also was named the MVP of the Green River Crossover Tournament in Auburn, Wash., on Dec. 19, at which BMCC took home the tournament championship.

In addition, Heugly earned a spot on the NWAC All-Star Team – one of just five women from the NWAC East Region to do so. Heugly was named to the 2016 NWAC All-Eastern Region first team and All-Defensive team for her outstanding efforts this season, as well as to the NWAC Winter Term Academic Excellence Team.

"It has been a privilege to have the opportunity to coach Savannah the last two years," said BMCC Head Women's Basketball Coach Adam Driver. "She is an outstanding young woman off the court and an excellent student. Her growth as a player over the last two years has been impressive. I truly believe Savannah will do great things at Western Oregon University and look forward to watching her continued growth over the next two years. It will be difficult to replace the production Savannah brought to the court, but it will be infinitely more difficult to replace what she brought to the program in terms of humility and character."
