Bosnian war survivor to share story at BMCC Hermiston July 25

HERMISTON, Ore. – Selena Hutchins is determined to bring a face to the topic of genocide. She'll do just that when she shares her own emotional journey of survival and building a life after genocide during a "Genocide: The Story of a Survivor" presentation July 25 at BMCC's Eastern Oregon Higher Education Center in Hermiston. The presentation is at 6 p.m. in Room 236, and is free to the public.

Hutchins will share her family's story of surviving the Bosnian war in 1992-1995 and building a life after genocide in the United States. Her work has been published in the Seattle Times, among other publications.
