- Transfers:** According to the National Student Clearinghouse, BMCC students are most likely to transfer to: Eastern Oregon University, Oregon State University, Walla Walla Community College, Central Oregon Community College, University of Oregon or Oregon Institute of Technology upon leaving BMCC.
- Retention:** 43% of credit students who did not graduate in 2014-15 returned for at least one credit class in 2015-16. Retention rate from fall to spring term was 64%.
- Financial Aid Stats:** 30% of BMCC deg/cert-seeking students are receiving some form of financial assistance. In 2015-16, \$6.9 million was awarded to 1,187 BMCC students for assistance with educationally related expenses.
- Matriculates:** 983 students applied for admission and 84.3% of those subsequently enrolled.
