



Passport *LDGE*
(Lower Division General Education)

The Passport Block is a learning outcomes based interstate transfer module sponsored by the Western Interstate Commission on Higher Education (WICHE), and supported by the Oregon Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

The Passport *LDGE* consist of coursework that meets learning outcomes in nine areas:

- **Foundational Skills:** Oral Communication, Quantitative Literacy, and Written Communication
- **Knowledge of Concepts:** Creative Expression, Human Cultures, Human Society and the Individual, and Natural Sciences
- **Crosscutting Skills:** Critical Thinking and Teamwork/Value System

General Requirements:

- **Total Credits Required:** 45-55 credits
- **Coursework must have been completed during or after the 2010-2011 academic year.**
- **Grade Requirement:** **All courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better**
- **Transfer Coursework:** Cannot be applied unless coursework was from a Passport approved college.
- **Courses may be used to satisfy up to two (2) learning outcome areas.**
