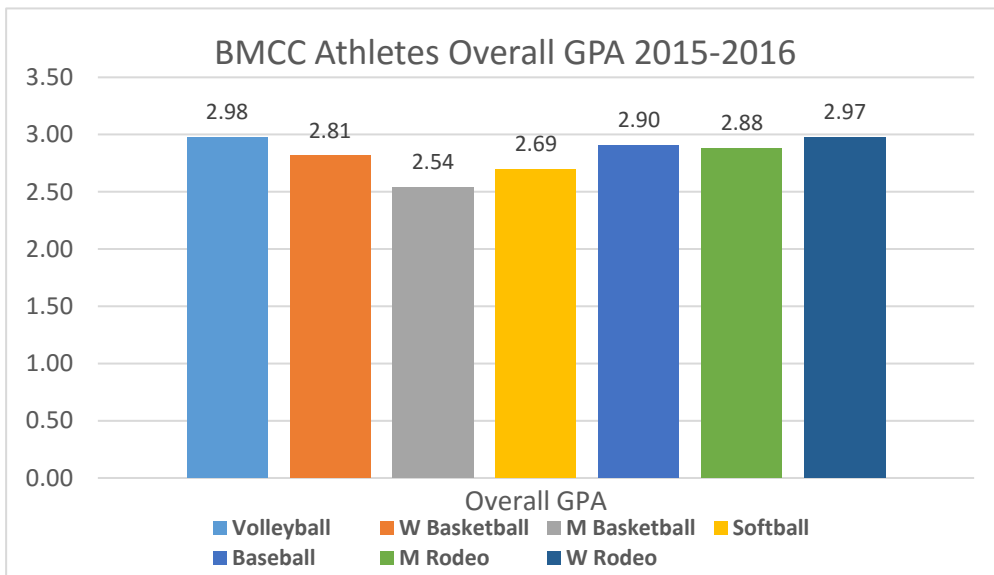
National Rodeo Champions back to back years 🙌

Rodeo had 12 sophomore student athletes, of those 12, four transferred on to a four year college and 6 moved on professionally in the sport of rodeo. 🙌

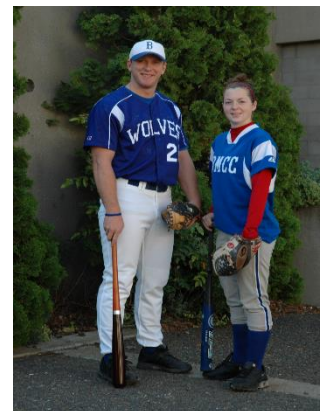
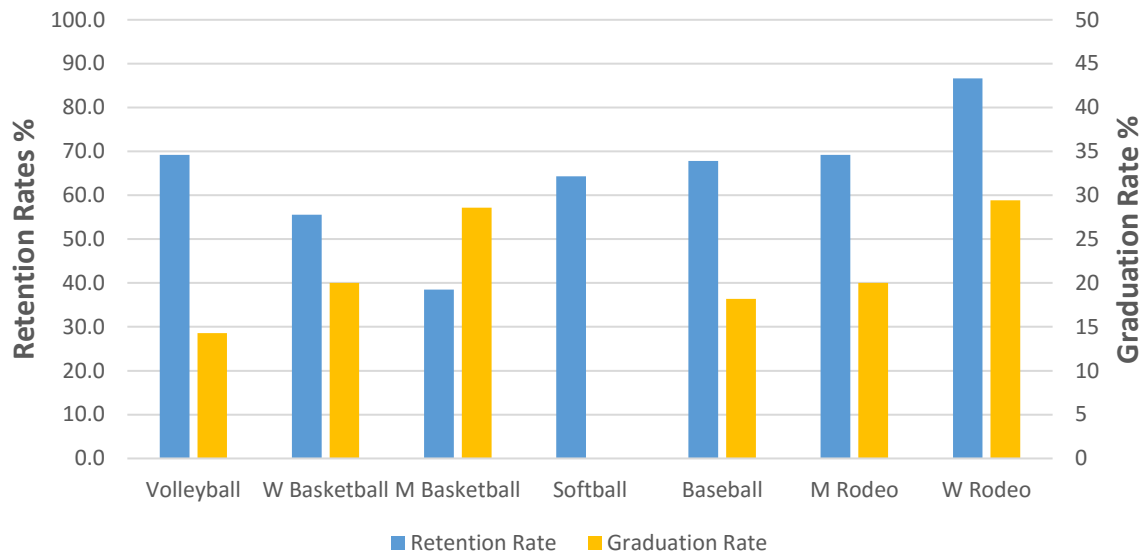
Athletics collectively raised \$105,462.00 for related program costs not covered by general budget. 🙌
